CONTRACT AS A MEMBER OF "TEAM CACI"**

Eatontown, N.J. - DSCI has announced today that it has entered into a subcontracting agreement with CACI International Inc., and awarded an indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity (IDIQ) contract to support the Engineering, Technical and Operations Support Services (ETOSS) program for the U.S. Army's Communications-Electronics Research, Development and Engineering Center (CERDEC) Intelligence and Information Warfare Directorate (I2WD). Under the terms of the five year (base), \$450 million vehicle, team CACI will "deliver scientific and engineering support to meet I2WD objectives of modernizing Army intelligence and information systems and capabilities." DSCI was also a member of the Team CACI ETOSS predecessor contract awarded in 2000: Technical, Engineering, Fabrication and Operations Support (TEFOS).
