DSCI Completes asset purchase of *i*²STAR, LLC - Marshall C. Phelps Jr. and Richard T. Gerstner join the DSCI Board.

Freehold, NJ – January 20th, 2006 -- DSCI announced today that it has completed an asset purchase of *i*²STAR, LLC (Interactive & Intelligent Simulators, Thrills, Attractions, and Rides). Terms of the deal are undisclosed.

DSCI, a Department of Defense contractor with corporate headquarters located in Eatontown, New Jersey, acquires *i*²STAR's flagship simulator attraction "Alcatraz The Ride" (<http://www.alcatraztheride.com>), located at Six Flags Great Adventure, Jackson NJ, as well as all of *i*²STAR's intellectual property. *i*²STAR provides state-of-the-art, interactive simulator attractions for the theme park and family entertainment center (FEC) markets, as well as products applicable to the online video gaming industry. Premiering their technology, *i*²STAR was awarded "Best Exhibit" at the amusement industry's primary trade show, IAAPA (International Association of Amusement Parks and Attractions). DSCI's CEO, Steven DeChiaro, said "DSCI has the core competencies necessary to take interactive entertainment into the 21st century."

DSCI will integrate assets acquired from *i*²STAR into its Commercial Products Group (CPG), with headquarters located in Westchester County, New York. The CPG has responsibility for interactive entertainment and transforming DSCI's core technologies and products for use in commercial applications.

DSCI will also add two giants of industry to their board.

Marshall C. Phelps Jr. - As Microsoft Corp.'s corporate Vice President and Deputy General Counsel for intellectual property, Mr. Phelps supervises Microsoft's intellectual property groups, including those responsible for trademarks, trade secrets, patents, licensing, standards and copyrights. He oversees the company's management of its intellectual property portfolio, which comprises some 33,000 patents and patent applications world-wide, and more than 11,000 trademark registrations. Richard T. Gerstner – Mr. Gerstner has his own financial consulting firm. He is the former President and CEO of Telular Corporation, an Illinois-based wireless communication company. Prior to joining Telular, he spent 32 years at IBM. He started as an industrial engineer and advanced to Vice President of Business Plans for IBM Europe, located in Paris. In 1983, he was promoted to Corporate Vice President. He continued his advancement to Group Executive in charge of IBM's Asia-Pacific operations stationed in Tokyo, and returned to the U.S. to lead IBM's Personal Computer line.

Steven A. DeChiaro – Mr. DeChiaro, DSCI's Founder and CEO, earned a Bachelors of Engineering in Electrical Engineering (BEEE) degree from the City College of New York of the City University of New York. During the past four years, Mr. De Chiaro has focused DSCI's vision, which has resulted in an average growth of 71%. Mr. DeChiaro has over twenty years experience as a systems engineer, with emphasis in first-principles modeling. He holds several patents and has authored and co-authored a series of technical publications. In recognition for his actions at the Pentagon as a result of the tragedy of September 11, 2001, on July 15, 2002, Mr. De Chiaro was awarded the Medal of Valor by the Department of Defense, which was presented by LTG Van Alstyne at the Pentagon, in the Hall of Heroes.
